

# **CENDRIS DATABASE MANAGEMENT**

## **DATA PROVIDER LICENCE**

These Data Provider Licence Terms and Conditions (“Data Provider Licence”) contain the terms and conditions specified by Cendris Database Management of Tauber 52, 2491 DA The Hague, The Netherlands (“Cendris”) in respect of your use of the Postcode and Address file of Koninklijke TPG Post (KTP Data) and supplementary files as developed by Cendris; and are incorporated into the QAS QuickAddress Licence Terms and Conditions between you and QAS (“the QAS Licence”) by reference.

### **1. DEFINITIONS**

All defined terms set out in the QAS Licence shall have the same meaning in the Data Provider Licence, unless otherwise specified herein.

### **2. LICENCE**

- 2.1 This Data Provider Licence provides you with the non-exclusive, non transferable right to use the KTP and Cendris Data.
- 2.2 You are only licensed to use the KTP and Cendris Data in conjunction with the QAS Licensed Programs. In no instance will Cendris accept liability for the functionality of the QAS Licensed Programs.
- 2.3 You are under no circumstances permitted to transfer, assign, novate or make available KTP or Cendris Data in any form or under any title, to any third parties, without the prior written permission of QAS. In the instances where prior written permission is not obtained from QAS, you will incur a penalty of € 7000, payable to Cendris.
- 2.4 The right to use the KTP and Cendris Data shall expire on the date notified to you by QAS.

### **3. OWNERSHIP**

All of the Intellectual Property Rights (including copyrights) in relation to all Products (including Data, data files and software) that are made available to the Customer, shall remain the property of Cendris and shall not be transferred to the Customer, unless agreed otherwise.

### **4. WARRANTIES**

Cendris does not in any way warrant the accuracy or completeness of the Data and shall not be liable for any loss or damage (whether direct, indirect or consequential) howsoever arising out of, or in connection with this Licence (or the Agreement of which it forms part) or its termination.
