To help you keep up with these changes, Experian Data Quality provides National Change of Address (NCOA) services that match each name and address in your database to the change-of-address reference files from both the USPS and Canada Post.

How it works

Taking advantage of our NCOA service is easy. Our service works through a simple step-by-step process:

- Your data is reformatted to conform to USPS and Canada Post standards, appending ZIP+4[®] for U.S. records and identifying a complete Canadian Post Code for Canadian records.
- Each name and address is matched against relevant postal files. Our service checks against the 48-month USPS NCOA file and the 72-month Canada Post Change of Address file.
- If a match is made against the relevant postal reference file, the match type and updated current address is returned when available.
- An updated file is returned to you in its original format along with a detailed breakdown of the results.

Additional features

Suppression data processing: Each name and address is checked against the Social Security Administration's Death Master File to identify deceased individuals dating back to 1999 and the Direct Marketing Association's (DMA) Mail Preference Service to identify individuals who have indicated they do not wish to receive unsolicited mail, as well as identifying addresses that are known prisons or businesses.

Apartment append: Optionally, our apartment append service can also be used to identify missing secondary information or update incorrect delivery details, helping to reduce the Undeliverable as Addressed (UAA) records in your mailing list.
